- Must have a minimum of ten (10) years of service as a head high school coach.
- Must have demonstrated a high level of professionalism as a coach.
- Must have demonstrated outstanding service in providing guidance/direction to student athletes.
- Must have earned the respect of student athletes and members of the coaching profession by exemplary sportsmanship
- Must be a member in good standing with the CHSCA

Win/loss records or championships attained are
NOT to be considered in nominating a coach.

The Athletic director and/or principal are requested to submit supporting evidence denoting why the nominee is deserving of this award. A resume for the nominee, as well as a supporting narrative written by a supervisor of the nominee, is required.
